# Religious Views on Abortion - Answers

<p>Muslim arguments against abortion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• It is against the sanctity of life.</li><li>• The Qur'an states that they should not kill their children if they cannot provide for them.</li><li>• The importance of family life and having children may lead to Muslims opposing abortion.</li></ul>	<p>Christian arguments against abortion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• They believe life begins at conception. It is therefore against the sanctity of life and counts as murder.</li><li>• They believe that it interferes with God's plan for life.</li><li>• They feel the potential child is innocent and should not be harmed</li></ul>
<p>Muslim arguments in favour of abortion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Life begins 120 days after conception, so abortion can occur before that date.</li><li>• Abortion can be allowed in this time period is if the mother's life is at risk.</li></ul>	<p>Christian arguments in favour of abortion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• It may be the loving thing to do in some situations.</li><li>• Some denominations allow it to protect the life of the mother.</li></ul>
